Parking Instructions

1. Here is a link to a map of the abortion clinic location along with three marked options for parking: <http://bit.ly/ofT2hf>. Each blue marker has instructions if you click on it.
2. Parking is also available in the neighborhoods surrounding the clinic. Please **DO NOT** block people's driveways and avoid parking in "No Parking" zones.
3. If you are traveling with a large group, please park in the neighborhoods rather than the three suggested locations on the map. This will avoid irritating the local businesses.
4. **DO NOT** park in the plaza where the clinic is located. That is private property and for customers only.
5. If parking across the street, please be very careful as this intersection is large and busy. It's not recommended for children. Please cross at the crosswalk and avoid jaywalking.

Guidelines

(The following will help campaign go as smooth as possible. Please respect them.)

1. **NEVER block the driveway going into the clinic plaza.** This will not only be a danger to you, but to those around you.
2. **DO NOT approach women**, unless they approach you first.
3. **Stand on the sidewalks only.** Please refrain from standing on the gravel or going into the parking lot at all. You may set your water bottle down on the sidewalk, but make sure path is clear for pedestrians.
4. **Keep the sidewalks clear.** If you are in a large group, make sure to stand shoulder to shoulder along the sidewalk, ensuring that people passing by have enough room to walk behind you.
5. **DO NOT yell, scream, or spread anything but the love of God** in a compassionate and peaceful manner. Always remember we are not there to judge, but to pray and to love.
6. **Bring a prayer partner with you** if praying after dark. It is encouraged to have someone with you during the day as well. This is for your safety and wellbeing.
7. **If approached by a heckler**, you are free to take a picture of their license plate or of the person and say that you will call the cops if they continue their behavior. Refrain from fighting. If you feel unsafe, call someone from the above list in the order given.
8. **Remember, you are ALLOWED to be there** thanks to the First Amendment. The police are aware we will be there and are familiar with the campaign. If anyone says you are not allowed to be there, that is untrue.
9. **You represent 40 Days for Life, Arizona Right to Life and most importantly, God** while you pray outside the clinic. Act respectfully, prayerfully and peacefully at all times.
10. **It's ok to smile** at the people walking in and out of clinic ☺ In fact, it's encouraged! Joy is contagious and as witnesses to the message of life and love, we have a lot to be joyful about. These people are not our enemies, rather our brothers and sisters who have believed a lie and we are to bring God's truth in love.
